PhotoVideoAffair.com (Tulsa, OK) offers a wide range of video event programming services and has a state of the art mobile production unit that is the heart of its operations. The mobile video production facility processes component video feeds from up to four (4) remote cameras. Camera feeds are connected to a video switcher inside the mobile unit.

MuxLab's Component Video/Digital audio Balun (500050) is being used to allow the three (3) component video cables to be replaced by a single Cat5 cable, thereby shortening the cabling setup time at any video event and simplifying cable manipulation and storage. Instead of carrying out heavy spools of coaxial video cable, lightweight and cost-efficient Cat5 cable is used instead.

A 500050 is installed at each camera and at each input of the video switcher inside the mobile unit. Video transmission is processed and monitored at a central console inside the mobile unit.
